Walks will be limited to twenty people to enable good communication.

Please bring suitable clothing for the forecasted weather, and sturdy footwear.

Phil and Steve are fully insured, licensed by the Forestry Commission, and trained first aiders. Phil is a member of the Institute for Outdoor Learning. We follow the country code. All walks are risk assessed.
